We can confirm that with consultation with our suppliers that all necessary steps have been taken to pre-register all substances and, where necessary, complete the registration as required by the REACH regulations.

We will ensure that any changes or amendments to the regulations and any additions to the Candidate List will be considered and all customers will be updated accordingly.

Where amendments to the regulations or additions to the Candidate List mean that any product will become non-compliant to the regulations, then all customers will be informed immediately of the product concerned and the relevant actions being taken.

Substances of Very High Concern

British Cables Company can confirm that none of the substances listed in the ECHA candidate list of substances of very high concern (SVHC) for authorisation issued 28th October 2008 and including the subsequent additions up to and including the latest amendment of July 2019, are present above a concentration of 0.1%w/w in any article supplied by British Cables Company.
